Delay condoned.

- 2. Leave granted.
- 3. It is seen that in a similar matter in Paramjit Panag & Ors. v. State of Punjab, this Court vide order dated 15.01.2015 has enhanced the compensation by Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lac only). Therefore, on the principle of parity these appeals are disposed of declaring that the appellants shall be entitled to an additional amount of Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lac only) per acre, over and above the amount granted by the High Court.
- 4. The appellants shall also be entitled to all the statutory benefits except for the period covered by the delay including the delay in refiling the special leave petitions.

- 5. Pending applications, if any, stand disposed of.
- 6. No costs.
