O R D E R

The Registry to provide copies of the report dated 14th August,

2024 of the Assam State Legal Services Authority to the learned ASG appearing for the Union of India and the learned counsel appearing for the State of Assam.

We have perused the affidavit dated 14th August, 2024 filed on behalf of the Ministry of Home Affairs of the Government of India. It will have to be a joint effort by both, the Union of India and the State Government, to deport the foreigners.

Before we go into the larger issue, both, the Government of India and the State Government, must tell us in what manner the foreigners, who are detained in the Transit Camp at Matia, will be deported. In paragraph 6 of the affidavit of the Ministry of Home Affairs, it is stated that in the case of two declared foreign nationals, the nationality status verification is pending with the Ministry of External Affairs from 2019. We direct the State Government to respond to the said affidavit within a period of two weeks from today.

As regards recommendations made in paragraph 10 of the report of the Assam State Legal Services Authority, the State Government will file a response before the next date.
