O R D E R

Mr. Kaustubh Anshuraj, learned counsel has moved an application for discharge of the previous counsel viz., Mr. Anand Mishra who was appearing for the applicant-intervener (viz., Mr. Shankar Shyamnaval Mishra).

The earlier counsel Mr. Anand Mishra has not issued NOC for the engagement of the new counsel for various reasons and one of it being that in the discharge application some accusation has been made which reflects upon his conduct as an advocate.

In view of the above, it is not a discharge simpliciter which is being sought.

I have perused the application for discharge and is satisfied that the said accusations are not warranted and therefore the counsel Mr. Kaustubh Anshuraj may withdraw the present application for discharge and file a simple application for getting the earlier counsel discharged without assigning any motives whatsoever.
